This is a Pattern of the Month. Anne Sommerlad has reproduced the Elizabeth Jefferson Coverlet from a photo she found in an old book called "Patchwork" by Avril Colby from the 1950's. With the use of the EQ quilting software she has drawn up the individual blocks and the quilt design. This quilt was originally made by Elizabeth Jefferson as a 10 year old in 1811. This quilt is very large, 96" square, with 8 boarders. Anne has made her sample using reproduction fabrics which we have on display in store for a short time for you to view. We are doing this quilt as a Pattern of the Month over 12 months. Anne has classes on the 3rd Friday of the month.
