BOOKING POLICY

Class fees must be PAID IN FULL at the time of booking to secure a place. Most classes need a minimum of 3-4 paid participants to be able to go ahead – numbers will be assessed 48 hours before the class is due to run.

CANCELLATIONS

Cancellations must be made by phone contact during business hours – refer to the Hobbysew website for store hours.

• Fees for cancelled bookings 48 hours or more prior to the class date will be transferred in full to another class date or returned in the form of a store credit.

• Cancellations within 48 hours prior to the class starting are offered a return of 50% of fees paid either in the form of a class transfer or a store credit. At this point a decision has been made to run the class and teachers need to be paid.

• All fees are forfeited if no contact has been made prior to the start of class or if choosing to leave before the session is complete.
